

May 7, May Long hike: 14 miles

This hike is continuing Appalachian Trail from Port Clinton to Eckville parking area. This section has 3 great lookouts of Blue Mt, Pulpit Rock and The Pinnacle. We will pass Pocahontas Campsite, Windsor Furnace shelter and Hamburg Reservoir plus 4 springs: Pocahontas, Minnehala, Gold and Panther Spring stream. There are lots of rocks out to Pinnacle, otherwise should be ridge and woods walking. Pace approx. 2.5mph depending on hikers. Wear sturdy hiking boots, bring plenty of water, snacks, lunch and hiking poles if needed. End of hike stop at Peanut Shop for anyone is interested.

May 7: Short Hike: 5 1/2 mile loop hike from Lock #12 parking lot (McCalls ferry rd.) starting on the Mason Dixon trail along the Susquehanna River past the Holtwood dam to McCall's fall trail. There will be osprey and the eagle's nests to see rock climbing, and a hill before we loop back on the ridge to the parking lot. Hiking shoes/boots, water and a snack.
